Thompson Turner Construction presented the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for Phase 1 of the proposed classroom addition projects. The GMP for Chesnee Elementary is \$4,598,687 and the GMP for Oakland Elementary is \$ 3,978,645. Administration recommends for approval.

\*Ms. Smith made the motion to approve the GMP for Phase I for the additions at Chesnee and Oakland Elementary Schools, which was duly seconded and carried, 8-0.

### ***12-15 Finance Report***

Mrs. Gist provided the financial report for the month of July 2022 and a revenue sheet as information.+

Mr. Pettit, District Procurement Officer, shared a report of the district’s annual minority business purchases, emergency purchases, and sole source purchases as required by the District’s Procurement Code.

Mrs. Gist presented the FY 2022-2023 General Fund Budget Amendment for approval as final reading. As part of the Budget Amendment, a recommendation was made to fund three additional teacher positions for FY 2022-23.

\* Mr. Seay made the motion to approve funding three (3) additional teacher positions for FY 2022-23 which was duly seconded and carried 9-0.

\*Ms. Smith made the motion to approve the FY 2022-2023 General Fund Budget Amendment, which was duly seconded and approved 9-0.

Mrs. Gist presented for approval the resolution to sell up to \$20M in general obligation bonds to finance maintenance and capital projects and to maintain and upgrade technology throughout the District.

\*Mr. Jackson made the motion to approve the Annual 8% Debt Resolution for up to \$20M in general obligation bonds, which was duly seconded and carried 8-0-1. (Mr. Seay recused himself due to a possible conflict of interest due to his occupation.)

### ***16 Public Relations Report***

Mr. Acosta shared good news happening in the District, including a video review of summer events, the Administrator’s retreat and Convocation.

### ***17-20 Superintendent’s Report***

Dr. Simmons gave a short update on legislative issues regarding education from Columbia.

Mr. Radford thanked the Board and Administrators for their continued support and trust. He shared that the graduation date for Chesnee High will be Friday, May 19, 2023 at 7:00pm and Boiling Springs High will be Saturday, May 20 at 9:00am.

Mr. McKillop invited the Board to complete the Board Feedback form.
